*Founder of FOCUS*

**CURTIS MARTIN** is the President and Founder of FOCUS, the Fellowship of Catholic University Students, one of the fastest growing programs in the Catholic Church. Archbishop Charles Chaput of Denver stated, "No one does a more dynamic job of reaching college students for Christ than FOCUS." He is an award winning speaker who uses humor, stories, and his own life experiences to communicate how faith

in God is lived out in everyday life. Curtis Martin holds a Masters degree in Theology and is co-host of the groundbreaking show Crossing the Goal, on EWTN. He is a co-author of Boys to Men: The Transforming Power of Virtue and Family Matters: A Scripture Study on Marriage and Family as well as a contributing author of Catholic for a Reason, Vols. I, II, III and IV. He was awarded the inaugural Excellence in Evangelization award by Envoy magazine. In 2004 Curtis and his wife Michaelann were awarded the Benemerenti Medal by Pope John Paul II for their outstanding service to the Church. He serves as an adjunct professor at the Augustine Institute in Denver, Colorado. Curtis and his beautiful wife Michaelann live in Greeley, Colorado with their eight extraordinary children.

**FATHER LARRY RICHARDS** was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Ordained to the priesthood in 1989 for the Diocese of Erie, Fr. Larry Richards serves as pastor of St. Joseph Church/Bread of Life Community in Erie. A gifted and captivating speaker, preacher, and retreat master, Fr. Larry Richards holds the answer to some of life's most profound questions. He speaks from experience as a pastor of an inner city parish, a high school chaplain, a counselor, and evangelist. Fr. Larry Richards has directed hundreds of retreats, parish missions and conferences for young and old alike. His inspirational talks and presentations, always authentic and enthusiastic, have changed the hearts, minds and lives of millions of listeners worldwide. Fr. Larry promises two things at his parish missions: One, you will never be bored and two, your life will be changed forever. Fr. Larry Richards is the founder and president of The Reason for our Hope Foundation, a non-profit organization dedicated to 'spreading the Good News' by educating others about Jesus Christ. Fr. Larry published his first book, "Be a Man! Becoming the Man God Created You to Be," in 2009. In his book he inspires men to become the true heroes they long to be—men of authentic courage, compassion and integrity.



Kerry Fraser  
Senior Referee

**KERRY FRASER** was a senior referee in the National Hockey League. He called his first game in the 1980-1981 season and retired in 2010. He called over 1,900 regular season games and over 260 Stanley Cup playoff games. Fraser also officiated the 1998 Winter Olympics in Nagano, Japan, which

was the first Olympic tournament to feature NHL participation. Kerry Fraser is on the board of Catholic Athletes for Christ and also speaks about his faith and conversion through CAC. He is also writing two books, including an autobiography scheduled for publication in 2011. (The other, a collection of humorous and entertaining stories from his career in hockey, will be published in September 2010.) Kerry knows that everyone's spiritual journey is different, and shares his in the hopes that others will find their own path toward God.

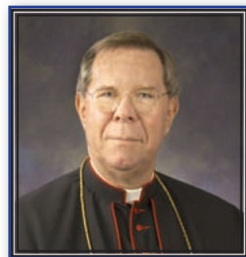

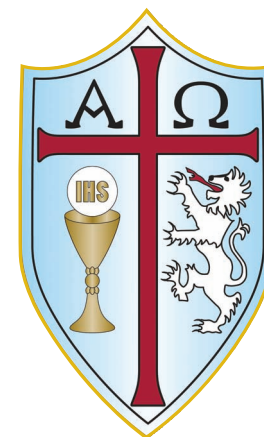
